

Part-time Veterinary Technology Instructors

The Veterinary Technology program is a distance education program. The coursework is primarily taught online. Instructors are needed for Summer 2010 term (May 27-August 9, 2010) to teach the following courses:

VET 120 – Vet Tech Clinics II (3 credit hours)

VET 122 – Vet Tech Emergency and First Aid (5 credit hours)

VET 126 – Animal Diseases and Immunology (3 credit hours)

VET 234 – Animal Pharmacology and Toxicology (3 credit hours)

Part-time Instructor Pay Rate: \$481.50 per credit hour.

Qualifications

1. Alabama licensed Veterinary Technician required, OR a valid out-of-state license with completion of the Alabama license within 30 days of employment required
2. Associate degree or higher in Veterinary Technology from an AVMA accredited program, required
3. Computer skills preferred
