**MINIMUM ADMISSION STANDARDS FOR THE ASSOCIATE DEGREE NURSING PROGRAM INCLUDE:**

1. Unconditional admission to the college. Refer to the current college catalog for detailed requirements.
2. Receipt of completed application for the Associate Degree Nursing Program.
3. Minimum of 2.5 GPA based on the required academic core courses.
4. Minimum of 2.5 high school GPA for students without prior college work.
5. Eligibility for English 101 and Math100 or higher (MTH 116 not accepted).
6. Good standing with the college. Check with Enrollment Services to make sure there are no holds on your account.
7. Must have a minimum composite score of 18 on the National or Residual ACT.

**Admission to the Associate Degree Nursing Program is competitive, and the number of students is limited by the number of faculty and clinical facilities available. Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee acceptance or campus preference.**

## NURSING PROGRAM APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Students must initial beside each statement below to ensure they meet the minimum admission criteria:

1. \_\_\_\_\_ Unconditional admission to the college. Refer to the current college catalog for detailed requirements.
2. \_\_\_\_\_ Completed nursing application. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
3. \_\_\_\_\_ Meet the essential functions required for nursing.
4. \_\_\_\_\_ Must have a minimum composite score of 18 on the National or Residual ACT test. There is no time limit on scores. It is the student's responsibility to ensure official ACT scores are on file in the Admissions Office by the application deadline.
5. \_\_\_\_\_ All official college transcripts must be on file in the Admissions Office by the application deadline.
6. \_\_\_\_\_ Minimum of 2.5 GPA is required on academic core college courses. The core college courses are: ENG101, MTH100 or higher, BIO201, BIO202, BIO220, PSY210, SPH106 or 107 & Humanities elective.
7. \_\_\_\_\_ Minimum of 2.5 high school GPA for students without prior college work (GED acceptable in lieu of high school transcript).
8. \_\_\_\_\_ Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA at current, native institution or cumulative 2.0 GPA at institution from which student is transferring.
9. \_\_\_\_\_ **Day Program only:** must be eligible to enroll in ENG 101 or have taken ENG101 and must be eligible to enroll in MTH 100 or higher or have taken MTH 100 or higher.
10. \_\_\_\_\_ I understand that I must pass a background screening that is acceptable to affiliate agencies by the scheduled Mandatory deadline.  
\*Admission to the program is not complete until the student has completed a background screen.
11. \_\_\_\_\_ I understand that I must pass a drug screening before I may attend clinical rotations.
12. \_\_\_\_\_ **Mandatory Orientation Conference** is required of all students admitted to the Nursing Education Program (NEP). Students are required to attend on the date scheduled by the program. Failure to attend may result in forfeiting your admittance into the NEP. Refer to the FAQ on the NEP webpage for more information. Scheduled date will be sent to successful applicants upon acceptance of place.  
\*Failure to disclose on application that you were previously enrolled in a nursing program may compromise your acceptance in the JSCC nursing program.

Admission to the program is not complete until the student has completed a background screen that is acceptable to affiliate agencies.

Note: the nursing education program is currently undergoing revision. Published guidelines and requirements are subject to change without notice. Updated information will be posted on the Jefferson State web site as available.

The Administrative Code of the Alabama Board of Nursing states grounds for denial of a license to practice as an RN include, but are not limited to, conviction of a felony or certain other criminal offenses, chemical dependency, mental incompetence, military court martial/discipline, disciplinary action by a state board of nursing and other reasons authorized by law or regulations. As a nursing applicant you are not required to divulge this information. However, it is important that you understand that successful completion of the nursing program does not guarantee eligibility to take the licensure exam. If any of the above circumstances may be applicable to you, you should contact the Associate Dean of Nursing Brenda O'Neal at 205 856-6028 to confidentially discuss your standing prior to submitting an application.
