



RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM CHECKLIST

Please review the following minimum requirements for the Radiology Technology program. Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee acceptance. It is important that you meet all requirements before applying. If you are missing any of the requirements, your application will be incomplete.

	<p>College admissions application Unconditionally admitted to the college.</p>
	<p>Must be in good standing with the college to include a minimum overall, cumulative GPA of 2.0.</p>
	<p>Radiology Program Application</p>
	<p>Official College Transcripts from all colleges attended ALL transcripts (including high school or GED and college) must be sent directly from the sending institution to Enrollment Services by the application deadline.</p>
	<p>Official ACT scores A minimum ACT score of 18 is required for program admission. ACT scores must be received from the National ACT by the college via ACT or High School Transcripts or Residual ACT scores from JSCC. The ACT must be completed with the appropriate score within 5 years of the application deadline and on file with the college by the application deadline.</p>
	<p>I am 18 years old at application deadline.</p>
	<p>Minimum GPA of 2.5 on the last 24 college credit hours attempted. If no College credit has been completed a cumulative final High School GPA of 2.5.</p>
	<p>Eligible to Enroll in MTH 100 or a higher level math course or have taken MTH 100 or a higher level math course. Refer to the current Jefferson State Community College catalog for course prerequisites or placement test score requirements. Note: MTH 116 is a lower level math and will not meet the curriculum requirements for the Radiology Program.</p>
	<p>Eligible to enroll in ENG 101 or have taken ENG 101. Refer to the current Jefferson State Community College catalog for course prerequisites or placement test score requirements.</p>
	<p>I have read and understand the Essential Functions with the program application.</p>
	<p>Mandatory Admission Orientation I understand that if I am admitted to the Radiologic Technology Program I am required to attend the Mandatory Admission Orientation Session on the date scheduled by the program. Failure to attend a mandatory admission orientation session may result in forfeiting your admittance into the RAD program. Refer to the FAQs on program’s web page for information regarding the Mandatory Admission Orientation Session.</p>
	<p>I understand that I must pass a background check by the scheduled Mandatory Admission Orientation session.</p>
	<p>I understand that I must pass a drug screen before I may attend clinical rotations.</p>
