  - A minimum of **360 HOURS** of **Clinical Veterinary Experience** is required **PRIOR** to **ENROLLMENT** in the Vet Tech Program.
    - The 360 hours of clinical experience **MUST** be under the supervision of a veterinarian.
      - You may **APPLY** for the Fall Semester if you are completing your 360 hours of clinical experience the Summer prior to the Fall you will enter the program.
      - You may apply for the Spring Class if you are completing your 360 hours of clinical experience the Fall prior to the Spring you will enter the program.
- A **Clinical Hours Verification Form** will be provided on **ACCEPTANCE** in the program.
  - This document is included within the Jeff State Veterinary Technology Acceptance Packet.
    - The veterinarian overseeing the student will sign off on the approximate hours worked/volunteered.

**CLINICAL SITE**

Students will work or volunteer 20 hours a week\* in a licensed veterinary facility within the state of **ALABAMA** while enrolled in the program. \*Students must work a minimum of 30 hours a week during the Preceptor Class the last semester of the program.

## **COURSE REQUIREMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS**

- **INITIAL** *each statement verifying that you have **READ & UNDERSTAND** the requirements as they apply to the Jeff State Veterinary Technology Program.*
  - ■ Veterinary Technology students will **perform** and **record clinical skills** at their **approved clinical site**.
  - ■ Clinical skills for Large Animal, Avian, Laboratory Animals, and Surgical Nursing may be completed at the student's approved clinical site or students may choose to attend **OPTIONAL Labs** taught by the Jeff State Vet Tech Instructors.
    - Optional Labs for Large Animal, Avian, Laboratory Animals, and Surgical Nursing require travel for students to the Birmingham area.
    - Students are responsible for their own transportation to all **OPTIONAL Labs**.
  - ■ Students are required to work/volunteer in their approved clinical site a minimum of 20 hours a week while enrolled in the program.
    - Students are required to work 30 hours per week during their Preceptor Course in the last semester of the program.
    - The student is responsible for securing a clinical site to work/volunteer in while in the program.
  - ■ **ALL EXAMS** must be **PROCTORED** using the Tegrity Proctoring System.
    - The Tegrity Proctoring System is included within all Vet Tech classes.
  - ■ All students in the Veterinary Technology Program must have access to a **computer** with high speed **internet connection** and a **web camera**.
  - ■ Students must have access to a **recording device** for videoing required clinical skills performed at the student's approved clinical site.
    - Most students utilize their Smart Phone for recording clinical skills.
  - ■ Veterinary Technology students are expected to adhere to the **Code of Ethics** relating to behavior on and off-campus, whereas student behavior is considered a reflection of our entire program.
    - Students found to be in violation are subject to dismissal from the program.
  - ■ All students in the Veterinary Technology Program are required to show proof of **medical insurance** prior to beginning the JSCC Vet Tech Program.
  - ■ All students in the Veterinary Technology Program are required to purchase **Professional Malpractice Insurance** through Jeff State.
    - This is a one-time charge of **\$15.00** that is paid at the Jeff State Vet Tech New Student Orientation
  - ■ A student who becomes **pregnant**, while enrolled in the Vet Tech Program, must inform the program.
  - ■ It is **strongly advised** that all students in the Vet Tech Program be **immunized** against **tetanus** and **rabies**.

## **Essential Functions for the Veterinary Technology Program**

As a student entering and participating in the Veterinary Technology Program, you must:

### **Physical Demands**

1. Have no life-threatening allergies to animals
2. Have good physical stamina and endurance which would not be adversely affected by having to lift, carry and balance at times more than 50 pounds (100 pounds with assistance)
3. Have the physical ability and agility to restrain varied species of animals, which include but are not limited to: dogs, cats, horses, cows, pigs, sheep, and various small laboratory animals such as mice, rats, hamsters, and guinea pigs
4. Have good hand-eye coordination and manual dexterity to manipulate equipment, instrumentation and medications
5. Possess eyesight in a minimum of one eye correctable to 20/20 vision

### **Problem Solving Abilities**

6. Be able to differentiate between normal and abnormal findings in animal physical conditions by using visual, auditory, olfactory, and tactile observations
7. Be attentive to detail and be aware of standards and rules that govern veterinary practices
8. Be able to collect facts and to organize data accurately, communicate clearly, both orally and in writing in the English language
9. Be able to make good judgment decisions and exhibit problem-solving skills under stressful situations

### **Work Characteristics**

10. Possess emotional stability to be able to perform duties in animal life and death situations
11. Be able to handle stress and work well as part of a team
12. Have a personality that is conducive to working well with veterinary clientele
13. Be able to work shifts of 24 hours in length
14. Be oriented to reality and not mentally impaired by mind-altering substances
15. Not be addicted to drugs or alcohol
