Blackboard Learn – Using Calculated Columns (Examples Using Grading Rubrics)

By default the **Total** and **Weighted Total** columns are listed in the **Grade Center**. Others can be manually created by the Instructor. Instructors can choose to release (show/hide) columns to students.

You can use calculated columns to do the following:

 Calculate the average grade 	 Calculate the total grade
 Calculate a minimum or maximum grade 	 Weight grades by column, category, or both

Total Column - By default, the Total column displays a running total of the items in all grade columns. You can edit the criteria for the Total column. You can use the Total Column (selecting categories) to drop grades.

A calculated column uses the data from two or more grade columns to make a calculation.



<u>Weighted Total</u> (default column) - can create a calculated column that weighs the data in grade or category columns. A Weighted Grade is a Calculated Column that displays the calculated result of quantities and their respective percentages.



You can also use weighted column to drop a grade:
