The Certified Nursing Assistant Preparation program at Jefferson State prepares students to deliver the necessary component of direct patient contact and care.



Certified Nursing Assistants are an important part of the health care industry. Students in this program will develop the skill set needed to supplement staffing in the community we serve. In addition, students will receive the appropriate training to be prepared for successful completion of the National Nurse Aide Assessment Program (NNAAP).

Successful candidates of the program will receive a certificate of completion from Jefferson State and have the option to sit for the NNAAP exam and become certified and listed on the Alabama Nurse Aide Registry. Certification exam costs are not included in the course fee.

\*\* Program includes a 20-hour clinical rotation at a long-term care facility. Hours could include weekdays, nights or weekends.

**\*\*Students must attend 100% of total clock hours based on State Nurse Aide education requirements. Students who do not complete 100% of course hours will not be permitted to enter clinicals or sit for the state exam.**

### Pay As You Go
