Respiratory Therapy Program Application Checklist

- I am unconditionally admitted to the College. Please refer to current catalog for detailed requirements.
- I am in good standing with the College including a minimum overall, cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- I understand that an applicant with a history of criminal arrest or convictions must discuss the matter with the Program Director.
- I have an overall cumulative 2.5 GPA or greater on all college courses.
- I have earned a grade of “C” (70) or higher on all general education prerequisites prior to starting the program (ENG 101, SPH 106 or 107, MTH 100 or higher, BIO 201, BIO 202, Humanities or Fine Arts elective, PSY 200). *Humanities/Fine Arts and PSY 200 may be completed after acceptance into the RPT Program, but is strongly encouraged to be completed prior to starting program. All other prerequisites must be completed no later than the summer term prior to starting the program.
- I have completed Biology 201 and 202 within the last 5 years.
- Official transcripts from ALL colleges previously attended are on file in Enrollment Services office by application deadline.
- I have earned an ACT score of 18 or higher (National or Residual) or SAT score of 940 or higher and have verified that official test scores are on file in Admissions Office by application deadline, or documented evidence of a Bachelor Degree or higher.
- I meet the *Essential Functions* and Technical Standards required by this program.
- I understand that once admitted, I must attend a **mandatory** Program Orientation. The time and date is to be determined.
- I understand that only those students who have met all the criteria and submitted all required paperwork by the deadline will be considered for admission.

Note: You will be notified by email and U.S. mail if you are accepted into this program. Your Jeff State email address will be used for official notification. No information will be given via telephone regarding your admission status. All applicants will receive notification of status.
