NURSING PROGRAM APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- □ Unconditional admission to BOTH JSCC and UAB. Refer to the current college catalog for detailed requirements. Students may be conditionally admitted to JSCC if they continue to take courses at another college the term prior to requested JE admission. If applying for fall admission, you must send transcripts at the end of spring **and** end of summer. If applying for spring admission, you must send transcripts at the end of summer **and** end of fall. All general education courses must be completed successfully prior to admission term requested.
- □ Must be in good standing with BOTH JSCC and UAB including a minimum overall, cumulative GPA of **2.5** on **ALL** college work.
- □ Completed Joint Enrollment nursing applications with **BOTH** JSCC and UAB. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. The UAB JE application is only available through Gail Holmes, UAB's JE Advisor.
- ALL official college transcripts must be on file in the Admissions Office by the application deadline.
- Must have a minimum composite score of 20 on the National or Residual ACT test. There is no time limit on scores. It is the student's responsibility to ensure that official ACT scores are on file in the Admissions Office by the application deadline. Contact the Testing Center at testing@jeffersonstate.edu for information on available Residual ACT dates and times. ACT scores cannot be older than 5 years at the time of the application deadline for the term you are applying.
- Minimum of 2.5 GPA is required on academic core college courses. The core college courses are: ENG101, ENG 102, MTH110 or MTH 112 {or higher}, BIO 201, BIO 202, BIO 220, CHM 104, CHM 105 or BIO 103, MTH 265 or BUS 271, PSY 200, PSY 210, SPH 106 or SPH 107, LIT elective, HIS elective, Fine Arts Elective, and Humanities elective.
- □ Meet the essential functions required for nursing.
- □ Must pass a background check by the scheduled Mandatory deadline.
- □ Must pass a drug screening before attending clinical rotations.
- Mandatory Orientation Conference is required of all students admitted to the Joint Nursing Education Program (NEP). Students are required to attend on the date scheduled by the program. Failure to attend may result in forfeiting your admittance into the NEP. Refer to the FAQs on the NEP webpage for more information.

Admission to the Joint Nursing Program is competitive, and the number of students is limited by the number of faculty and clinical facilities available. <u>Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee acceptance</u>.

The nursing education program is currently undergoing revision. Published guidelines and requirements are subject to change without notice. Updated information will be posted on the Jefferson State web site as available.
