



Jefferson State Community College Equity in Athletics (EADA) Report

The following report has been completed using data from September 1, 2020 through August 31, 2021.

1. JSCC enrolled 922 male full-time undergraduates and 1,496 female full-time undergraduates, resulting in a total of 2,418 full-time undergraduate students for the Fall semester. There were 7,765 female students and 4,519 male students during the year. Racial breakdowns were as follows:
 - a. 61 American Indian or Alaska Native
 - b. 329 Asian
 - c. 2578 Black or African American
 - d. 390 Hispanic
 - e. 19 Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander
 - f. 8306 White
 - g. 433 Two or more races
 - h. 170 Not reported
2. \$53,627 was spent on athletically-related student aid for male athletes in competition, and \$29,848 was spent on athletically-related student aid for female athletes.
3. 64 percent of athletically-related student aid was awarded to male student-athletes in competition, and 36 percent of athletically-related student aid was awarded to female student-athletes.
4. In total, \$95,745 in expenses was incurred by JSCC for men's athletics in competition, \$80,009 for women's athletics, and \$216,174 for the athletic department overall. Please note that there were \$40,420 in general expenses not attributed to a specific program for the year.

5. No money was spent on recruiting for the men's or women's teams in this reporting year.
6. \$95,745 in revenue was received by JSCC for men's athletics, \$80,009 for women's athletics, and \$216,174 for the athletic department overall.
7. The head coach for the men's golf team earned a salary of \$10,000, and the head coach for the women's golf team earned a salary of \$13,375 during the reporting year. The head coach for the men's team was a part-time contractor. The head coach for the women's team was a full-time staff member assigned to work with the team part-time.
8. The head coach for the men's cross-country team earned a salary of \$3,000, and the head coach for the women's cross-country team earned a salary of \$3,000 during the reporting year.
9. Jefferson State Community College was a member for NJCAA Division I golf and Division II cross-country during the 2020-2021 reporting year, with men's and women's teams in each sport.
 - a. 10 student athletes participated on the men's golf team, 5 student athletes participated on the women's golf team, and 1 student athlete participated on the women's cross-country team. These numbers represent the unduplicated head count for all participating student athletes in this reporting year.
 - b. The head coach for the men's golf team was a male, part-time contractor. The head coach for the women's golf team was a female, full-time institutional employee who was assigned to the team on a part-time basis.
 - c. The head coach for the men's and women's cross-country team was a male, part-time contractor.
10. The overall graduation rate was 16%. The transfer-out rate was 34%.
