## **Teaching Assistants- Hand in Hand Early Learning Program**

Full-time and Part-time opportunities available.

Assists the classroom teacher in implementing lesson plans; attends to child's basic needs; and provides materials for children to use during learning and playing.

Essential Duties, Responsibilities, and Decision Making:

- Assists the classroom teacher in managing the classroom including implementing behavior strategies, writing daily notes, and writing therapy reports.
- Attends to children's basic needs, including implementing tube feedings, using adaptive equipment for feedings, changing diapers, etc.
- Assists the teacher in implementing lesson plans and goals including facilitating center time, small groups, and circle time.
- Required to be in the assigned classroom at beginning of shift and remain in classroom until scheduled end time unless otherwise instructed by leadership.

Qualifications, Background, and Experience Required or Desired:

- Experience teaching or assisting in a daycare or pre-school environment required, or commensurate education.
- Experience teaching or assisting pre-school special needs children preferred.

Education, Certifications, or Licenses Required or Desired:

- Bachelor's degree in related field preferred, or Child Development Associate credential (CDA) , or working toward equivalence.
