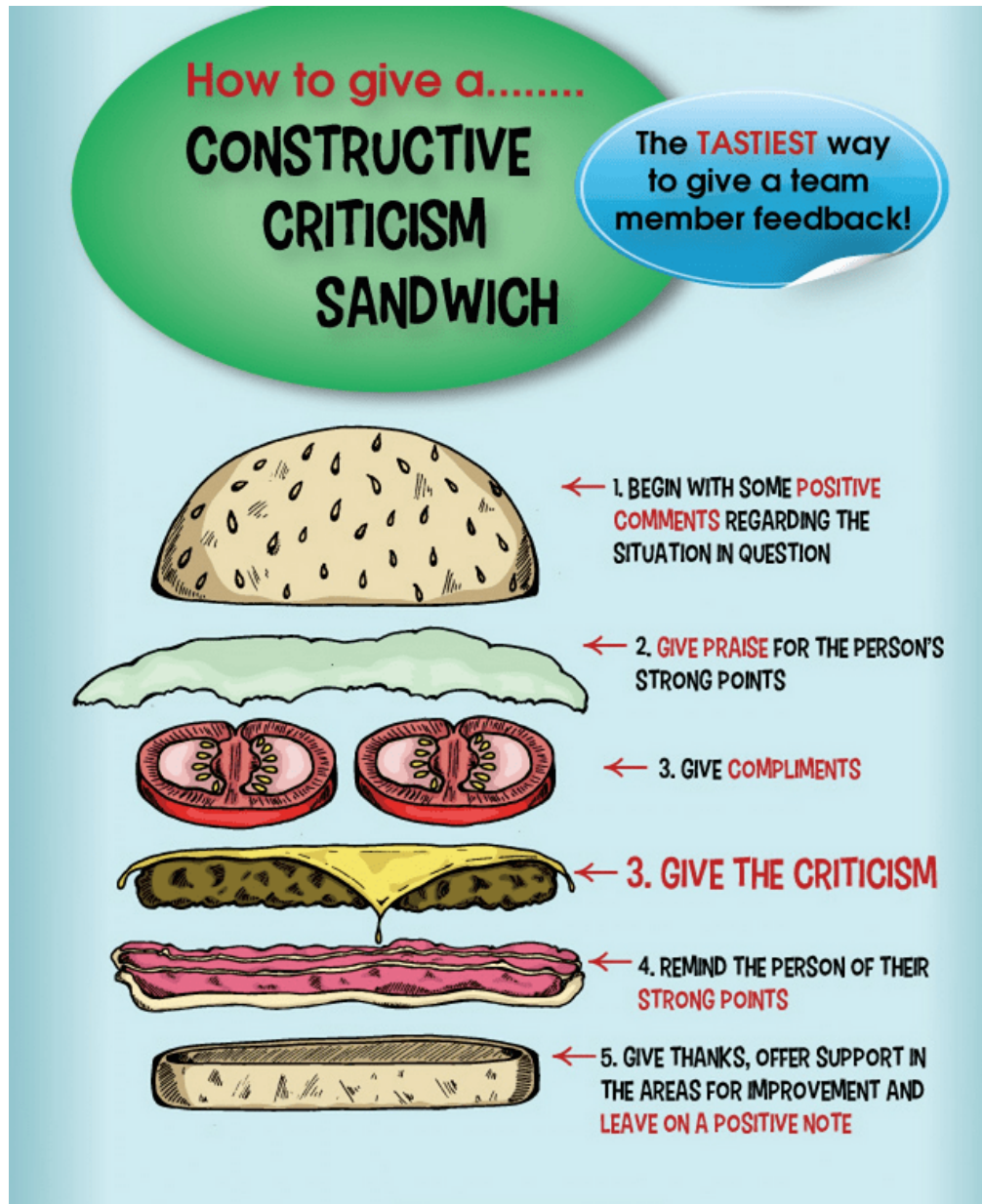


Criticism Sandwich

The comic shows a progression of items to add to your criticism sandwich when providing feedback to students.



1. Start with praise (bottom piece of bread says "You are a genius")
2. Add some minor changes (slice of cheese says "Please fix the typos")
3. Layer on more praise (next piece of bread says "Brilliant")
4. Add the meat of the criticism (large piece of meat says "criticism")
5. Another helping of praise (next piece of bread says "You have a gift")

6. Cover a few minor edits (piece of lettuce says “minor edits”)
7. Finish with praise (top piece of bread says “This is your opus”)
8. Bon appetit (image shows the instructor dressed as a chef handing over the criticism sandwich to a student that replies “I don’t eat meat”)
