This program is designed for entry-level coders with little-to-no work experience. Coding Internship is a 3 to 6 months temporary work-study program. Intern is expected to learn and develop coding skills and expertise and demonstrate ability to learn quickly. Within the first 4 weeks of the program, Intern is expected to have basic coding skills and ability to work independently with minimal supervision. By the completion of the program, Intern is expected to accurately assign ICD-10-CM, CPT, ICD-10-PCS codes to inpatient encounters at a solid productivity and accuracy rate.

CODING SPECIALIST - JOB SUMMARY:

This job requires ability to demonstrate solid productivity and accuracy rate of coding. Ability to accurately assign ICD-10-CM, CPT, ICD-10-PCS codes to inpatient encounters according to established guidelines. Review medical records and work with other staff to promote specificity in physician documentation and ensure compliance with state and federal regulations. Assigns inpatient hospital coding as well as all other assignments given by supervisors as needed.
