Jefferson State Community College Equity in Athletics (EADA) Report

The following report has been completed using data from September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2022.

1. JSCC enrolled 876 male full-time undergraduates and 1,345 female full-time undergraduates in the Fall semester, resulting in a total of 2,221 full-time undergraduate students. There were 7,733 female students and 4,476 male students during the year. Racial breakdowns were as follows:
 - a. 49 American Indian or Alaska Native
 - b. 329 Asian
 - c. 2751 Black or African American
 - d. 447 Hispanic
 - e. 10 Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander
 - f. 8012 White
 - g. 530 Two or more races
 - h. 83 Not reported
2. \$33,743 was spent on athletically-related student aid for male athletes in competition, and \$33,620 was spent on athletically-related student aid for female athletes.
3. 50.1 percent of athletically-related student aid was awarded to male student-athletes in competition, and 49.9 percent of athletically-related student aid was awarded to female student-athletes.
4. In total, \$91,042.68 in expenses was incurred by JSCC for men's athletics in competition, \$40,220.17 for women's athletics, and \$146,516.85 for the athletic department overall.

Please note that there were \$15,254 in general expenses not attributed to a specific program for the year.

5. No money was spent on recruiting for the men's or women's teams in this reporting year.
6. \$91,042.68 in revenue was received by JSCC for men's athletics, \$40,220.17 for women's athletics, and \$146,516.85 for the athletic department overall.
7. The head coach for the men's golf team earned a salary of \$15,998.64 , and the head coach for the women's golf team earned a salary of \$16,122.20 during the reporting year. The head coach for the men's team was a part-time contractor. The head coach for the women's team from September 1, 2021 to July 31, 2022 was a full-time staff member assigned to work with the team part-time. From August 1 to August 31, 2022, the head coach for the women's team was a part-time contractor.
8. The head coach for the men's cross-country team earned a salary of \$4,166.70, and the head coach for the women's cross-country team earned a salary of \$4,166.70 during the reporting year. The head coach for the men's & women's teams was a part-time contractor.
9. Jefferson State Community College was a member for NJCAA Division I golf and Division II cross-country during the 2021-2022 reporting year, with men's and women's teams in each sport.
 - a. 11 student athletes participated on the men's golf team; 6 student athletes participated on the women's golf team.
 - b. 2 student athletes participated on the men's cross-country team; 1 student athlete participated on the women's cross-country team. These numbers represent the unduplicated head count for all participating student athletes in this reporting year.
 - c. The head coach for the men's golf team was a male, part-time contractor. The head coach for the women's team from September 1, 2021 to July 31, 2022 was a full-time institutional faculty assigned to work with the team part-time. From August 1 to August 31, 2022, the head coach for the women's team was a part-time contractor.

- d. The head coach for the men's and women's cross-country team was a male, part-time contractor.
10. The overall graduation rate was 21%. The transfer-out rate was 35%.
