Please review the following minimum requirements for the Radiology Technology program. Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee acceptance. It is important that you meet **all** requirements before applying. ***If you are missing any of the requirements, your application will be incomplete.***

	<p><b>College admissions application.</b> Unconditionally admitted to the college. Refer to the current catalog for detailed requirements.</p>
	<p><b>Must be in good standing with the college</b> to include a minimum overall, cumulative GPA of 2.0</p>
	<p><b>Radiology Program application.</b> Incomplete applications will not be considered.</p>
	<p><b>Official College Transcripts from all colleges attended. ALL</b> transcripts (including high school or GED and college) must be on file in the Admissions Office by the application deadline. <b><i>All transcripts must be final, 'in progress' or 'partial' transcripts will not be considered.</i></b></p>
	<p><b>Official ACT scores</b> A minimum ACT composite score of 18 is required for program admission. The ACT must be completed <b>within 5 years</b> of the application deadline. ACT scores must be received from the National ACT or High School transcript or Residual ACT scores from JSCC or any community college in Alabama by the application deadline. <b>ACT Super Scores will not apply.</b> To verify your scores are on file, go to the <b>Jeff State YouTube Channel</b> for instructions: <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=NCaDevNKZHK">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=NCaDevNKZHK</a></p>
	<p><b>I am 18 years old</b> at the application deadline.</p>
	<p><b>Minimum GPA of 2.5</b> on the last 24 college credit hours attempted. If no college credit has been completed a cumulative final high school GPA of 2.5 will be used.</p>
	<p><b>Eligible to enroll in MTH 100</b> or a higher-level math course or have taken MTH 100 or a higher-level math course. Refer to the current Jefferson State Community College catalog for course prerequisites or placement test score requirements. Note: MTH 110 and MTH 116 is a lower-level math and will not meet the curriculum requirements for the Radiology Program.</p>
	<p><b>Eligible to enroll in ENG 101</b> or have taken ENG 101. Refer to the current Jefferson State Community College catalog for course prerequisites or placement test score requirements.</p>
	<p>I have read the <b>Essential Functions</b> with the program application.</p>
	<p><b>Mandatory Admission Orientation</b> I understand that if I am admitted to the Radiologic Technology Program, I am required to attend the <b>Mandatory Admission Orientation Session</b> on the date scheduled by the program. Failure to attend a mandatory admission orientation session may result in forfeiting your admittance into the RAD program. Refer to the FAQs on the program's web page for information regarding the Mandatory Admission Orientation Session.</p>
	<p>I understand that I must <b>pass a background check</b> by the scheduled Mandatory Admission Orientation Session.</p>
