

The Annual Graduation Ceremony will be held on Friday, May 3, 2024, at 1:30 p.m.

Degrees and Certificates will be conferred at the ceremony. The ceremony is expected to last 2 hours.

Who is eligible to participate in the ceremony?

All pending graduates for the 2024 spring semester, as well as all graduates from the 2023 summer and fall semesters are encouraged to participate. This event will be livestreamed on our website – http://www.jeffersonstate.edu/graduation2024.

Guest Policy and Safety Protocols

Graduates are limited to **four** guests. A ticket is required for each guest. Tickets may be obtained from the Pioneer Bookstore beginning **April 3, 2024,** on our Jefferson and Shelby Campuses. <u>This also applies if you order your cap, gown, & hood online</u>. They will also be available in the Graduation Office at our Jefferson Campus.

Please take extra precautions for friends/family who may plan to wait outside since the weather can be hot at this time of year. Guests may not enter the theatre until 12:30 p.m.

What do I need for the ceremony? Cap & Gown

Online orders will be accepted from now until March 29th through https://jeffersonstate.shopoakhalli.com. Online orders will include a \$15.95 shipping charge. Or purchase your cap, gown, & hood from the Jefferson or Shelby-Hoover Campus Bookstore between April 3, 2024, and no later than April 26, 2024. The cap, gown, & tassel fee is \$60.00 plus tax. The hood is \$41.98 and is required. The fee for an extra tassel is \$8.98 plus tax. You are encouraged to wear a white honor cord if your grade point average is 3.5 or higher; a gold honor cord if you are a PTK member; a green and gold honor cord if you are a member of Sigma Kappa Delta; or a purple honor cord if you are a member of Sigma Chi Eta. Graduation Honors

Students must have completed a minimum of 24 semester credit hours at Jefferson State to be eligible for graduation honors.

The fee for each honor cord is \$18.98 plus tax. All fees must be paid at the time you place your order. Honor stoles purchased from Phi Theta Kappa may be worn. Extra caps, gowns, hoods, and tassels <u>will</u> **not** be available at the ceremony.

Diploma Scrolls

While on stage, you will receive a commemorative diploma scroll signifying the day's event. If you ordered a diploma, it will be mailed to you within 4-6 weeks after grades have posted for the spring semester.

Printed Programs

Commencement programs with a full listing of student names, hometown, and degrees will be distributed at the ceremony to graduates and guests. If you do not wish for your name to be listed in the program, you must contact the Graduation Office to request that your information be excluded by **April 12, 2024.**

Personal Attire and Academic Apparel Do's and Don'ts

- Do not iron your gown. Simply steam the wrinkles or hang it up.
- The mortarboard (cap) must rest flatly on the head with the point coming directly in the center of the forehead. Tassels must be worn on the right side of the mortarboard.
- You are allowed to decorate your cap!
- Only official honor cords and organization cords are allowed.
 This includes PTK, SCE, and SKD and honor cords (white).
- Men are requested to wear dark (black or navy) pants, white shirt, and optional tie. Please wear dark shoes and socks and no sandals.
- Women are requested to wear dark dresses or pants (cool fabric), dark low heel or flat shoes. No high collars or bows at the neck. Also, no corsages or jewelry on the robe.
- All valuables should be left with family members or guests prior to arriving at check-in. Do not leave purses, keys, or other personal items unattended. The college and the Alabama Theatre are not responsible for items left at the event.
- Cell phones and other electronic equipment should be turned off
- Improper attire, signs, and insignia will be addressed or removed by any staff member and marshals.
- Face masks may be required for graduates and guests.

Disability Access

Accessible seating is available for guests on a first come, first serve basis. Sign language interpreters will be providing services during the graduation ceremony. Parking

Parking is limited around the Alabama Theatre, so please plan to arrive early to secure adequate parking. We highly recommend carpooling. Central Parking has several lots around the venue.

Note: If you are unable to participate in the commencement ceremony after you have registered and/or purchased your cap and gown, please notify the Graduation Office by email at graduation@jeffersonstate.edu to have your name removed from the marching list. Contact the Bookstore at chcollins@bncollege.com for information regarding a refund for the cap and gown by 10 a.m., May 3, 2024. A refund will not be given if you do not notify the Bookstore by this time. A receipt is required, and the cap, gown, and hood must be in the same condition as they were when purchased.
