

## **Respiratory Therapy Program Checklist**

Please review the following **requirements** for **the Respiratory Therapy program**. It is important that you meet **all** requirements before applying. Meeting all requirements does not guarantee acceptance.

	<b>College admissions application.</b> I am unconditionally admitted to the college. Refer to the current catalog for detailed requirements.
	I am in good standing with the college including a minimum overall, cumulative GPA of 2.0
	I understand that an applicant with a history of criminal arrest or convictions must discuss the matter with the Program Director.
	I have submitted a Respiratory Therapy program application. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
	I have an overall cumulative <b>2.5 GPA or greater</b> on <b>all</b> college courses attempted, including graduate level.
	I have earned a grade "C" (70) or higher in the required general education courses: <b>ENG 101, SPH 106 or 107, *MTH 100 or higher, BIO 201, BIO 202, Humanities or Fine Arts elective &amp; PSY 200.</b> All general education courses must be completed no later than the summer term prior to starting the program, except for a Humanities /Fine Arts elective and PSY 200. These electives may be completed after acceptance into the RPT program. However, it is strongly encouraged to be completed prior to starting the program.
	I have completed <b>Biology 201</b> and <b>Biology 202</b> within the last five years.
	<b>Official</b> college transcripts from <b>ALL</b> colleges attended are on file in Enrollment Services by the application deadline. <b>transcripts must be final. "In progress" or "partial" transcripts will not be considered</b> .
	Official ACT composite score of 18 or higher within 5 years of deadline (National or Residual), or official SAT score 940 or higher within 5 years of deadline, or proof of bachelor's degree must be on file with the college by the application deadline.
	I meet the Essential Functions and Technical Standards required by this program.
	I understand that once admitted, I must attend a <i>mandatory</i> <b>Program Orientation</b> . The time and date are to be determined.
	I understand that only those students who have met all the criteria and submitted all required paperwork by the deadline will be considered for admission.

\*Beginning Fall 2024, Math 110 (Finite Mathematics) will no longer satisfy the Math requirement for the Respiratory Therapy program. Students applying to the Fall 2024 program with Math 110 will be accommodated.
