

Respiratory Therapy Program Checklist

Please review the following **requirements** for **the Respiratory Therapy program**. You must meet **all** requirements before applying. Meeting all requirements does not guarantee acceptance. *If you are missing any of the requirements, your application will be incomplete.*

College admissions application. I am unconditionally admitted to the college. Refer to the current catalog for detailed requirements.
I am in good standing with the college, including a minimum overall, cumulative GPA of 2.0
I understand that an applicant with a history of criminal arrest or convictions must discuss the matter with the Program Director.
I have submitted a Respiratory Therapy program application. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
I have an overall cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater on all college courses attempted, including graduate courses.
I have earned a grade "C" (70) or higher in the required general education courses: ENG 101, SPH 106 or 107, *MTH 100 or higher, BIO 201, BIO 202, Humanities or Fine Arts elective & PSY 200. All general education courses must be completed by the summer term before starting the program, except for a Humanities/Fine Arts elective & PSY 200. These electives may be completed after acceptance into the RPT program. However, it is strongly recommended that you complete all general education courses before beginning the program.
I have completed Biology 201 and Biology 202 within the last five years.
Official college transcripts from ALL colleges attended are on file in Enrollment Services by the application deadline. All transcripts must be final. "In progress" or "partial" transcripts will not be considered.
Official ACT scores or proof of a bachelor's degree (or higher) must be on file by the application deadline A minimum ACT Composite score of 18 or higher and a minimum Science sub-score of 18 or higher within 5 years of the deadline is required.
I meet the Essential Functions and Technical Standards required by this program.
I understand that once admitted, I am required to attend a <i>mandatory</i> Program Orientation. The time and date are to be determined.
I understand that only those students who have met all the criteria and submitted all required paperwork the deadline will be considered for admission.
