ALL hours must be supervised and signed by a licensed RT using official JSCC RP Program Observation Forms. Hours must involve exposure in a hospital-based acute care setting, inpatient facility, or physician clinic. Observational hours must be achieved within 1 year of the deadline date to be considered for points. <b>Observation hours</b> 20 or more hours = 5 points, 17-19 hours = 4 points, 14-16 hours = 3 points, 11-13 hours = 2 points, 8-10 hours = 1 point.	<b>5.0</b>
